
ALL ABOUT FIRE


FIND THE SMOKE ALARMS




Smoke alarms should be inside each bedroom and outside sleeping areas. There should also be at least one smoke alarm on every floor of your home.

WHEN THE ALARM SOUNDS


Follow these steps when you hear a smoke alarm sound.

outside meeting place.




Call the fire department.

You should know two ways out of every room and two ways out of your house. Can you find two ways out of this room?




CHOOSE A MEETING PLACE

Your meeting place should be outside your home where firefighters can see you.




